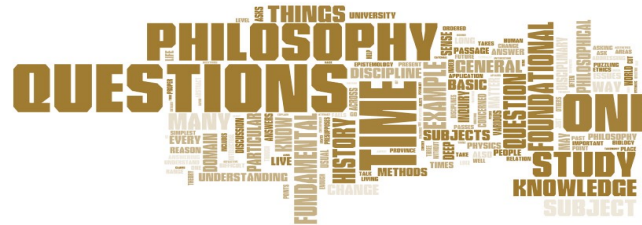


# BEING GROUNDED IN OUR CHARISM
